a freehold estate within said Town of the annual Income of three

pounds or any estate to the Value of sixty pounds, to Meet at

the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 7th Day of

May next at One O'clock in the afternoon, for the purpose

of choosing a Representative to Represent them in the General

Court Appointed to be convened and held at Boston on the

Last Wednesday of May next - Hereof you are not to

fail of Making Return of this warrant with your doing

thereon to some one of the selectmen previous to opening

said Meeting - - -

holders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury in
the County of Middlesex, Qualified according to the Consti-
-tutions having been duly convened in Town Meeting on
the 7th Day of May last, for the choice of one Representa-
-tive in the Legislature of this Commonwealth, did then
and there elect Capt Isaac Gibbs he being an Inhabitant
of said Town and Qualified as the Constitution requires to
Represent them in the General Court to be convened and
held on the Last Wednesday of the same Month -
Thus the Town voted to Resolve this Meeting
