Ls. You are hereby required in the name of the common
wealth of Massachusetts, to Notify & warn all the Freeholders
and other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified by Law
to Vote in Town affairs to assemble at the Meeting House
in said Town on Monday the 7th Day of May next at
3 O'clock in the afternoon on said day there and then to
on the following articles Viz —

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To bring in Town Debts & Credits
- 3^d To see if the Town will grant to the Rev^d Rufus Hurlbut
his salary the year ensuing to do or act as the Town shall
think best where met —
- 4th To see if the Town will grant Money for the support of
a grammar school for the year ensuing & order where the
same shall be kept to do or act —
- 5th To see if the Town will grant Money for the support of
a Reading & writing school for the year ensuing and
order where the same shall be kept to do or act —
- 6th To see if the Town will grant Money for the relief
of the Poor belonging to said Town for the year ensuing
to do or act —
- 7th To see if the Town will grant Money to pay their Taxes
and Assessors for the present year to do or act —
- 8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable person
to take care of & sweep the Meeting House ring the bell
and dig graves as occasions may require for the
year ensuing to do or act —
- 9th To see if the Town will act on the 12th article in the
warning of March Meeting & refer? to April Meeting and
from April to May Meeting for further consideration —
- 10th To see if the Town will grant a suitable sum of Money
to teach a singing school for the year ensuing to do or act —
- 11th To see if the Town will grant Money for the purpose
of paying the expense of a Road Portioned for by Mr John
Knowles & others which has been laid out & accepted by the boards
of selectmen to do or act —
