of Sudbury to be heard and tried at Concord at the next
Court of sessions which will be on the 8th of May next or at
any other Court which the same may come before to do or act
- 13th To see if the Town will except of the settlement made by indivi-
duals with John A. Phelps respecting his taking the Bible
Bacon & blotter from the Meeting House in said Town
to do or act
- 14th To see if the Town will except of reports of committees
if any should appear to be made to do or act
- 15th To see if the Town will find the soldiers a Dinner on
Muster Day like with the Remainder of their Powder
that is not allowed them by Law on Muster Day, to do or act

warrant with your doing thereon to some one of
the selectmen previous to appearing said Meeting
given under our hands & seals at Sudbury aforesaid
this 16 Day of April. A.D. 1821
