noon, on said day then & there to act on the following
Articles Viz - -

- 1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, selectmen Town
Incar, Assessors, Constable, and all other Town
Officers required by Law to be annually chosen
in the Month of March or April - -
- 2^d To see if the Town will Repair their Highways by a
Rate the present year & grant a suitable sum of
money for repairing the same - -
- 3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine
to go at large the present year - -
- 4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Horses,
Mules and Meat cattle to go at large the present year - -
- 5th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to go
at large without a shepherd the present year - -
- 6th To see if the Town will except of the settlement
of the selectmen with the Town Incar and order
the same to be recorded - -
- 7th To see if the Town will take the same Measures
for the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may be
Assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town as was
Adapted the year past, and to agree with some suitable
person or persons to collect the same for the year
ensuing to do or act as the Town shall think best when met - -
- 8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable person
for a school Committee and authorize them to agree
with and hire school Instructors & Instructresses to
Instruct all the public schools in said Town for the
year ensuing to do or act - -
