

March Anno Domini - 1822

9th Article Voted to except of the report of the trustees of the Ministerial Donations fund as follows hereafter recorded

By an act of the Legislature of this Commonwealth of Massachusetts passed June the 14th 1817 establishing a Ministerial fund in the Town of Sudbury making it a duty of the Trustees thereof to make a report to said Town the state of said fund, and thereon doing thereon at the annual Meeting in the Month of March or April agreeable to said act, said trustees ask leave to report as follows. The funded sum consist of the following promissary Notes of hand bearing date August 30th 1817

The Interest arising from the funded sum which was due Augt^h 30th 1821, amount to the sum of - \$192-05 which sum the Treas^r has since paid to the Rev^d Rufus Hurlburt agreeable to the act of incorporation and by order of said trustees thereof the sum of \$192-05
