(Ls) Middlesex. To Mr Samuel Knight Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in said County - - - - - Greeting
You are hereby required in the name of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn all the Inhabitants
of said Town, Qualified by Law as is provided by the Com-
-stitution of this Commonwealth, to vote in the choice
of Gov^r Lieut⁻ Governor & Senators for the year
ensuing to assemble at the Meeting House in said
Town on Monday the 1st day of April next at
1, O'clock in the afternoon, on said day then and
there to give in their votes for the choice of Gov^r
& Lieut⁻ Gov^r of said Commonwealth and Senators
for the Middlesex District for the year ensuing -

this warrant with your doing thereon to some one
of the Selectmen previous to opening said Meeting
