To Middelers &c. To Mr Samuel Knight Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in said County. — — — — — Greeting

You are hereby required in the name of the Com-
monwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the
Inhabitants of said Town Disqualified by the Constitution of this
Commonwealth to vote in the choice of Representatives
and all others Disqualified as the Law directs to vote in
Town affairs to assemble at the Meeting House in said
Town on Monday the 1st Day of April next at 3 o'clock
in the afternoon on said day then and there to act on
the following articles (viz) — —

1st To chosse a Moderator — —

2^d To bring in Rates for some suitable person for a County
Treasurer for the year ensuing — —

Also to bring in their Rates for some suitable person for
Register of Deeds for said County — —

3^d To fill Vacancies in those Town officers which the Law
requires should any office appear to be Vacant — —

4th To see if the Town will act upon 2^d, 6th, & 7th articles
in the warning of March meeting and referred to April
Meeting for further consideration — — — —

5th To see if the Town will take any measures to purchase
a poor House & Land to provide for the poor of said
Town to do or act as the Town shall think best when
mett — — — — —

6th To see if the Town will give any encouragement for
the destruction of Towns the present year to do or act — —

7th To see what the Town will do with the money recd
from the sale of the Bible and damage recd for taking
the sd acre to do or act — — — —

8th To see if the Town will paint the Meeting House
and do other repairs round the same — —
also to see if the Town will cut up part of the
body seats into pews to do or act — —
