to meet at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday
the 6th Day of May next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon
for the purpose of choosing a Representative to represent
them in the General Court Appointed to be convened
and held at Boston on the last Wednesday of May next

warrant with your doing thereon, to some one of
the selectmen previous to opening said Meeting —
