- 4th To see if the Town will grant Money to pay their Treas^r and Officers the present year to do or act
- 9th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable person to take care of & sweep the Meeting House ring the bell and dig graves as occasion may require for the year ensuing to do or act
- 10th To see if the Town will act on the 5th 6th 7th & 8th Articles in the warning of April Meeting & Refer^d to May Meeting for further consideration
- 11th To see if the Town will take any Measures to ascertain whether the Highway Surveyors for 1820 and 1821 have worked out all the taxes committed to them for the purpose of Repairing the Highway for said year to do or act
- 12th To see if the Town will purchase a stove or stoves to be placed in the Meeting House in S^d Town to do or act
- 13th To see if the Town will take any Measures to build an engine House in case there is one purchased by subscription to do or act
- 14th To see if the Town will furnish their soldiers a dinner on Muster day & also Powder on said day to do or act
- 15th To see if the Town will allow to the Heirs of Reuben Maynard Interest on the sum App^d as damage for land taken belonging to said Heirs for Mr John Brown road untill they rec^d their pay to do or act it being a request of said Heirs
- 16th To see if the Town will grant Money for the support of a singing school the year ensuing to do or act
- 17th To see if the Town will discount to their collector such Taxes as cannot be collected to do or act
- 18th To see if the Town will except of a List of J^{ns} as presented by the selectmen to do or act
