Also granted the sum of \$30-00 to supply the several schools
with wood to be equally divided between ^{the} five school districts 30-00

7th Article granted for the support of the Poor belonging
to said Town for the year ensuing the sum of \$900-00

8th Article granted to pay their Taxes for the year ensuing — 10-00

Also granted to pay their Assessors the present year 20-00

9th Article the Town voted to authorize the selectmen to let
out the care of the Meeting &c as was expressed in said
article

to be acted on —
