- 10th Article also containing 6th article in the warning of April Meeting and referred to May, past over —
Also the 7th article in said April Meeting the Town voted to have the proceeds of the sale of the New Bible and the damages had for taking the B. one paid over to the Town Treas^r —
Also contains the 8th article in said Meeting and the Town voted to appoint a Committee & to consist of the selectmen and authorize them to make the necessary repairs round the Meeting House and to draw from Treas^r any unappropriated money for the same and the Town voted to pass over the rest of said article —
- 11th Article the Town voted to choose a Committee & to have it consist of four & the following Gent^l were chosen William Hunt Jonathan Rice Adam How & Asher Goodnow to make the necessary inquiries as Express in said article —
- 12th Article past over —
- 13th Article past over —
- 14th Article the Town voted to furnish their Militia officers & soldiers with a Dinner on Muster day if there should be any Muster the present year —
Also voted each soldier that does duty on Muster day half pound of Powder to be delivered by the selectmen out of the Town stock —
Then the Town voted to have the selectmen furnish the above dinners and have granted the sum of \$40- to pay for the same — \$40 = 00
- 15th Article past over —
- 16 Article granted for the support of a singing school 30 = 00
Then the Town voted to choose a Committee to see to the laying out of said grant & the following Gent^l were chosen Dea Samuel Puffer Abel Wheeler Isaac Gibbs as a Committee for the above —
- 17th Article Discounted to Samuel Knight Comptable
