Middlesex, ss. To Mr Samuel Throft Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County a Greeting
You are hereby required in the name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify and
warn all the male Inhabitants of said Town,
of twenty one years of age & upward; except
(Paupers and persons under Guardianship) who
are qualified by the constitution of this Common-
wealth to vote in choice of Representatives in
the General Court of said Commonwealth
to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town
on Monday the fourth day of Nov^r next, that
being the first Monday of said month, at one
O'clock in the afternoon, to give in their votes
for a Representative of the people of said Com-
monwealth in the Congress of the United
States for the Middlesex district —

Hereof you are not to fail of making due
return of this warrant with your doing
thereon to some one of the Selectmen
previous to opening said Meeting —
