

April Anno Domini 1823.

At a legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts qualified by the Constitution to vote for Gov^r & Sen^t Gov^r & Senators & Councillors of said Commonwealth, holden on Monday the seventh day of April A.D. 1823. then the Inhabitants proceeded to the business of said day by bringing in their votes for the following persons.

Col. John Wade one hundred fifty six votes

Samuel Gore Esq four votes
Hon. William Austin five votes
Hon. John Abbot three votes
Samuel Gore Esq one vote
