You are hereby required in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn
all the Inhabitants of said Town Qualified by the
Constitution of this Commonwealth to vote in the choice
of Representative and all others Qualified as the Law directs to
Vote in Town appears to Assemble at the Meeting House in said
Town on Monday the 7th day of April next at 3.0 clock in
the after noon on said day then and there to act on the follow-
ing Articles viz. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

- 1st To chuse a Moderator ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 2^d To bring in Votes for some Suitable Person for a County Treas-
urer for the year ensuing ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 3^d To fill Vacancies in those Town offices which the Law requires
(viz) a Treasurer and Constable and all others that shall appear
to be vacant ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 4th To act upon the 6th article in the warning of March Meeting
and put of to April Meeting for further consideration
- 5th To see if the Town will except of the Settlement of the Selectmen
with the Town Treasurer and order the same to be recorded
- 6th To see if the Town will appoint an Agent or Agents to prosecute
the Town of Stow for the Support of Eli Gaults and family
Should the said Town of Stow refuse to pay the expense
that has already arisen or may arise for their Support
to do or act any way as the Town shall think best when met
- 7th To hear reports of Committees Should there be any reports made
- 8th To see if the Town will sell all the land belonging to said
Town that is not occupied as a road from the old training
field near Jonathon Clarke so on by Mr Israel Wheelers to Logg
Stow, also from Lakes end hill to Lancaster old road near
Mr Benj^r Rice that is not usefull as a road to do or act &
it being a request of Mr Luke Haynes ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 9th To see if the Town will make any repairs on the meeting House
in said Town to do or Act ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 10th To see if the Town will repair Wash Bridge the present year
to do or Act ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

with your doings there on to some one of the Selectmen
previous to the opening of said meeting ~
