Pursuant to the within warrant I have duly notified the Inhabitants of said Town qualified as within mentioned to meet at time and place and for the purposes within mentioned -

At a legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury on Monday the 7th day of April A.D. 1823 - Proceeded to the 1st Article of said and took up the first Article and made choice of Asher Goodnow Esq for Moderator

2^d Article brot in their votes for a County Treasurer as follows
For John Keyes Esq one hundred and thirty seven votes
For Capt Enock Kidder two votes - - - - -

3^d Article brot in their votes for a Town Treasurer and made choice of Capt Enock Kidder for their Treasurer then passed over the remaining part of said Article for the present. And took up the 4th Article containing the 6th Article in the warning of March Meeting, and voted to adapt the same measures in every perticular in regard to the collection of the Taxes as was adapted the last year. then the Town voted to take up the 3^d Article again and chose Mr Samuel Knight for their Constable by an unanimous vote. said Knight to be the collector of Taxes the present year, by giving bonds to the satisfaction of the Treasurer. Then the Town excused Mr Hunt Esq from serving as one of the Highway Surveyors. And made choice of Mr John Haynes in his stead. then the Town excused Mr Haynes from serving as Surveyor of Highways and made choice of Josiah Adams in his stead then the Town reconsidered their last vote of the choice of Mr Adams and made choice of Mr John Haynes for in his stead viz for a Highway Surveyor - - - - -

5th Article voted to except of the settlement of the selectmen with the Town Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded. as is hereafter recorded (viz)
