Pursuant to a Law of this Commonwealth the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of said the Town of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex Qualified according to the Constitution having been duly convened in Town Meeting on the 5th day of May Current for the choice of one Representative in the Legislature of this Commonwealth did then and there elect Abel Whistler Esq he being an Inhabitant of said Town and Qualified as the Constitution requires to represent them in the General Court to be holden at the City of Boston on the last Wednesday of May Current having the Number of fifty four votes Capt Isaac Gibbs had fifty three votes

Then the Town by their vote Dismissed this Meeting

To Mr Samuel Knight Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County. — Greeting you are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the Male Inhabitants of said Town Qualified by Law to vote in Town affairs to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 5th day of May next at 3 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To Chuse a Moderator
- 2^d To bring in Town debt and credits
- 3^d To see if the Town ^{will} grant to the Rev^d Rufus Hurd his Salary the year ensuing to do or act
