Also the committee appointed at the last March Meeting for the purpose of selling the Towns land on Lakes end Hill so called reported as followers (viz) That there is no land lying on said Hill belonging to the Town worth selling, and we consider it as useless for the town to take any measures for that purpose. Said report was excepted by the Town.

Also the committee appointed at April Meeting for the purpose of examining the Meeting House for the purpose of obtaining what repairs are necessary ~~repairs are~~ to be made, did report in favor of repairing said House and the Town voted not to except of said report. .

Also Asher Goodman Esq who was appointed to purchase a bathing^{tub} by said town reported that he had purchased said tub and the expense of it was fifteen dollars and it was ordered to be kept at the house of Dr A. Kidders for the use of said Town.

11th The town granted the sum of \$ 35.00 Dollars for the purpose of furnishing^{ing} Souldgers that did duty on thursten day a dinner and the commanding officers are to draw an order on the Treas^r for the above sum to be equally distributed and also to make up a half Pound of Powder to each Souldger with the quarter the the law allows them and no more -

12th Voted to appropriate money out of any unappropriated money now in the Treasury for the purpose of paying the expense of the erection of the grind Posts and boards

13th passed over not acted upon

14th The town voted to order the Treas^r to collect all the promissary notes now due the Town within the year for which he is elected, so that the money can be accounted for at the next settlement of the Treasurer

15th passed over not acted upon

16th The Town Discounted its Constable Knight Uriah Lorr Josces for the year 1822 the sum of \$ 1.28
