[SS] You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to notify and warn the freeholders and all
other Inhabitants of said Town qualified by Law to Vote
in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting House in said
Town on Monday the 25th of August Instant at 3 O'clock
after noon then and there to act on the following Articles
(viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To see if the Town will chuse an agent or agents to
defend a Law Sute brate by the Town of Concord against
the Town of Sudbury for the support of Reuben Balcom
and Samuely to do and act any way on this article as shall
seem best when met.
- 3^d To see if the Town will take any measures for the purpose
of removing a fence that Mr Luke Haynes has erected
around the Towns land on or near Lakes end hill so
called, and also all other fences that incloses Towns land with
out the consent of said Town to do or act se —
- 4th To see if the Town will take any measures to repair
Wash Bridge to do or act se —
- 5th To see if the Town will take any Measures for the purpose
of furnishing the pulpit window with a blind or a curtain
in the Meeting house in said town to do or act se —

Warrant with your doings there on to some one of
the Selectmen previous to the opening of said Meeting
given under our hands and seal at Sudbury this
11th day of August A.D 1823.
