Middlesex, Jr. To Mr. Samuel Knight Constable
of the Town of Sudbury in said County. - Greeting

You are hereby required in the name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify
and warn all the freeholders and other Inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury Qualified by Law to Vote
for Town officers and Town affairs, to assemble at the
Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 1st day
of March next at 12 O'clock at noon on said day
then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas.
Assessors, Constable, and all other Town officers required
by Law to be chosen annually in the Month of March
or April.
- 2^d To see if the Town will repair their Highway by
a rate the present year, and grant a suitable sum
of Money for repairing the same.
- 3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for Swine, horses,
Mules, and neat cattle to go at large the present year.
- 4th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to go at
large without a Shepherd the present year.
- 5th To see if the Town will take the same measures for
the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may be assessed
upon the Inhabitants of said Town as was adopted the
last year and to agree with some suitable person or
persons to collect the same for the year ensuing to
do or act as the Town shall think best when Met.
- 6th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons
for a School Committee and authorize them to agree with
and hire Instructors and instructresses to instruct all
the public Schools in said Town for the year ensuing
to do or act as.
- 7th To see if the Town will attend to the report of the trustees
of the Sudbury Ministerial fund Corporation, the state of
the funds and the interest arising thereon, And also to
attend to reports of Committees if any are offered to be made.
- 8th To see if the Town will appoint a Committee to examine in
and adjust all accounts that shall be brot in against
said Town.
- 9th To see if the Town will paint the Meeting House, and
make all repairs as shall be necessary on said House.
