- 11th To See if the Town Build a poor house in said Town to do or act and act as the Town shall think best when met.
- 12th To See if the Town will except of a road as laid out by the Selectmen Petitioned for by Lett. William Brigham and others. . . .

Hence of you are not to fail of Making a return of this warrant with your doings there on to some one of the Selectmen previous to the opening of said meeting given under our hands and Seal at Sudbury this sixteenth day of Feb. 7 A.D 1824. . . .
