7th Article continued. The committee on lands reported
as follows (viz) and was accepted.

Your committee appointed at a town Meeting
held at Sudbury in August last past for the purpose
of removing a fence that Mr Luke Haynes had erected
around the Towns land, and all other fences that inclose
towns lands with out the consent of said town

Have attended to that service and ask leave to report
(viz) the land that Mr Luke Haynes has inclosed
your committee are of opinion that it is a public
Highway. your committee find a small tract
of land inclosed by Mr Walter Haynes adjoining
the the Road which we find was fenced in by said
Haynes, with out the consent of the town. your
committee ^{there} fore recommend that the town to take
some Measures to see that the said fence be removed

8th Article Voted to chuse a committee ^{for} the purpose as
was expressed in said Article and the gentleman
selectmen were chosen for that purpose. . . .

9th Article the Town Voted to chuse a committee for the
purpose of viewing said house and see what repairs are
necessary to be made there on and to report to the
Town at April Meeting and the following gentleman
were chosen (viz) Mr Samuel Jones, Capt Isaac Gibbs
Capt. Wm Brigham, Mr Benkenston Capt Wm Rice

10th Article Voted to let out the poor of said town as has
ben the practice for years past.

11th Article put over to April Meeting for further consideration

12th Article the Town Voted to except of the road as laid
out by the selectmen through land of Capt Wm Rice and
Capt Tilly Smith, and recorded in the Book of records of roads
