You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to Notify all the Inhabitants of said Town qualified by Law to Vote in the Choice of Representative and all others to Vote in the Choice of Town officers, and Town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said Town on Monday the 5th of April next at 3 O'clock in the after noon on said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz) ---

- 1st To chuse a Moderator. ---
- 2^d To bring in their Votes for some Suitable Person for County Treasurer for the year ensuing. ---
- 3^d To chuse a Town Treasurer, and Constable (the Choice of which was put off from March Meeting to April Meeting) and fill all other Vacancies in Town officers that shall appear to be Vacant. ---
- 4th To see if the Town will Reconsider their Vote passed at the March Meeting in 1824, to accept of the report of the Selectmen that they had laid a road about Seventy rods in length through the land of William Rice and Capt. Tilly Smith, South of the dwelling house of said Rice, or discontinue said ^{road,} or revoke their order passed at March Meeting, to act, any way on this article as the Town shall think best when Met. ---
- 5th To see if the Town will Grant a Suitable Sum of money for the purpose of paying Capt. William Rice Damages and for making a road laid out and excepted by the Town at the March Meeting through the land of the said Rice. ---
- 6th To see if the Town will act on the 5th and 11th articles in the warning of March Meeting and refer to April Meeting for further consideration. ---
- 7th To see if the Town except of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer and order the same to ^{be} recorded. ---
- 8th To attend to reports of Committee if any are offered. ---
- 9th To see if the Town will chuse a Committee to settle with Farwell Eager, for a horse that was damaged on the North road on the 16th Instant to do or act as the Town shall think best when Met. ---
