At a Legal Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of Sudbury
held on Monday the 5th day of April A.D. 1824.
proceeded upon the business of said day and took up the first
1st article and Made choice of Capt Isaac Gibbs for Moderator
2^d then the town proceeded to bring in their votes for county
Treasurer, as follows (viz) John Keyes Esq had one
hundred and nine votes.
3^d Article Made choice of Asa Goodnow Esq for their
Town Treasurer. — Then the town voted to pass over
the remaining part of this article and took up that part
of the 6th Article which contains the 5th article in the
warning of March Meeting which was referred to April Meeting
and voted to adapt the same Measures as was adapted the
last year in respect to collecting their Taxes, then voted to take up
the remaining part of the 3^d Article and Made choice of
Mr Samuel Knight for their Constable and collector of
Taxes — Then the Town voted to excuse Wm Hunt Esq from
