- 4th To see if the Town will grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School for the year ensuing and order where the same shall be kept.
- 5th To see if the Town grant Money the support of a reading and writing School and order where the same shall be kept
- 6th To see if the Town will grant Money for the relief of the the Poor belonging to said Town for the year ensuing
- 7th To see if the Town will grant money to pay their Treasurer and Assessors for their services.
- 8th To see if the Town authorize their Selectmen to let out the taking care of the Meeting House and sweeping the same ringing the Bell and digging graves as occasion may require for the the present year.
- 9th To act on the 11th Article in the warning of March Meeting and referred to April Meeting so on to May Meeting for further consideration.
- 10th To see if the Town will act on the 4th 5th 7th and 8th Articles in the warning of April Meeting and referred to May Meeting for further consideration.
- 11th To see if the Town will grant money for the support of a singing School the present year and appoint a committee to see to the laying out of the same.
- 12th To see if the Town furnish their Militia Soldiers a Dinner and Powder on Muster day that do duty on said day to do or act as the Town shall think best when meet.
- 13th To see if the Town will take some Measures for the purpose of logging or walling the laws way on the North road near Mr John Haynes.
- 14th To see if the Town will appropriate out of any unappropriated money sufficient to take up all out standing orders and for other uses for the benefit to said Town, to do or act as the Town shall think best, and also to compensate Mr Joseph Lutter for the trouble in taking care of his Mother prior to his making application to the Selectmen.
