

May Anno Domini 1824 - - - - -

At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 3^d day of May
AD 1824. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the
1st Article and made choice of Col Drury Fairbanks Moderator

- 2^d passed over for the present - - - - -
- 3^d granted to the Rev^d Mr Hurlbut in addition to the Interest arising
from the Ministerial fund the sum of - - - \$ 457 95
- 4th granted for the purpose of the support of the Grammar School 375.00
to be equally divided among the several School Districts - - -
Also voted to grant the sum of thirty dollars for wood. . . . 30.00
- 5th granted for the purpose of a reading writing School - - 150.00
to be equally divided among the several School Districts
- 6th granted for the support of the Poor of said Town - - 1000.00
- 7th granted to pay the Treasurer the present year - - 10 00
granted to pay the Assessors for their services - - - 20 00
- 8th Voted to authorize the Selectmen to let out the taking
care of the Meeting House as was expressed in said Article
- 9th The Town Voted to choose a committee of three Persons for
the purpose of Ascertaining what saving it will be to the
town to have a poor house and Farm by making enquiry
in other Towns where they have a Poor establishment and the
following gentleman were chosen for the purpose above mentioned
(viz) William Hunt Esq. Asher Goodnow Esq and Capt. Enoch Thidder
and to report to the Town at some future Meeting their doings
- 10th Article which contains the 4th Article in the warning of April
Meeting and voted to discontinue the road that was laid out by
the Selectmen and executed by the Town at March Meeting
last past through the land of Capt William Rice and Capt Jilly
Smith South of said Rice. Also the 5th article in the warning
of April Meeting the Town voted to pass over said article and
not to act upon it. Also the 7th Article in the warning of
April Meeting the Town voted to execute of the Settlement
same to be recorded as follows
