

May Anno Domini 1824 -

Then the Town took up the 8th Article in the warning of April Meeting and refused to May Meeting, by a Motion being made to reconsider their vote of not excepting the report of their Committee appointed to examine the Meeting House which report was in favor of painting said house and making some other repairs and the motion being put and it passed in the negative.

13th The Town Voted to chuse a Committee of five for the purpose of viewing the lawsway near Mr. John Haynes and see what repairs are necessary ~~repairs~~ to be made on said lawway and to report to the Town at some future Meeting and the gentleman Selectmen were chosen for the purpose.

14th The town voted to appropriate money out of any unappropriated surplusant to take up all out standing orders. Also voted to appropriate money surplusant to ^{pay} Harwell Bager for his horse killed on the north road. And also voted to pay Mr. Joseph Luther fifty Dollars for taking care of his Mother in her last sickness out of any unappropriated money now in the Treasurer.

Then the town voted to take up the 2^d Article and granted the sum of \$92. 67 for the purpose of paying sundry accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts as follows (viz)
