Sudbury in said County.

55. In the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn all the freeholders and other Inhabitants of said town qualified by law to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said town on Monday the 13th day of September next at one o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To chuse a Moderator -----
- 2^d To see if the town will paint the Meeting house & Make such other repairs on said house as the town shall think best when met and grant a suitable sum of money for making said repairs.
- 3^d To see if the town ^{will} alter the body seats into Pews in said house and also some of the gallery seats into Pews in said house to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think best when met.
- 4th To see if the town will ~~attend to the~~ order the Treasurer to collect all the promissary notes now due the town.
- 5th To see if the town will attend to the reports of Committees if any reports are offered -----
- 6th To see if the town will purchis a stove for the Centre school house and appoint a Committee to purchis said stove.
- 7th To see if town will build a stone stile across the road near Mr Daniel Buffers go to do or act be -----
- 8th To see if the town will give liberty for a stove to be erected in the Meeting house provided one can be procured by subscription.
- 9th To see if the town will appropriate all unappropriated money that is now in the Treasurer or May be in the Treasurer from promissary notes to be collected to any use that the town shall think best.

Here of you are not to fail of making a returne of this warrant with your doings there on to some one of the Selectmen previous to the opening said Meeting
