(H) In the name of the Commonwealth of Mass-  
achusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn  
all the Inhabitants of Sudbury to assemble at the  
Meeting house in said town on Monday the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of November next at 2 o'clock in the after-  
noon on said then and there to act on the following  
Articles (viz)

- 1 To chuse a Moderator . . . . .
- 2<sup>d</sup> To hear the report of the Meeting house committee  
and to take any Measures on said report as the town  
shall think best when Meet. . . . .
- 3<sup>d</sup> To see if the town take any Measures for the purpos  
of removing the wall that Mr Walter Haynes has  
set near the Pound in said town
- 4<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will take any measures for the  
purpos<sup>s</sup> laying stones on the laws way near Mr  
John Haynes agreeable to the report then  
committee which was made in September last
- 5<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will take appoint a committee  
for the purpos of looking up the plan of the meeting  
house ~~Common~~ common
- 6<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will take Measures for the purpos of letting  
out their poor to one contractor for a term of years agreeable the report  
of the poor house committee which was made at September last past.
- 7<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will open the road which was laid out in Feb, y  
last by the selectmen through Capt Wm Rice and Capt Jilly Smiths  
land and excepted at our last anual March Meeting it being by the  
request of Capt Wm Brigham and others.

Hereof you are not to fail of making a return of this warrant with  
your doings, thane on to some one of the Selectmen previous to the  
opening said meeting.
