

November Anno Domini 1824

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 1st day of November 1824. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of Mr John Hunt for Moderator.

Then the Town voted to pass over all the articles for the present and take up the 6th article in said warrant and after some time being spent upon said article a motion was made to adjourn the meeting to the next Monday week at this place and it passed in the affirmative and accordingly it was adjourned to the 8th day of November at 12 O'clock at noon.

Sudbury November 8th 1824.

The Town being met at time and place agreeable to the foregoing adjournment and proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 6th article in said Warrant at a motion was made to choose a Committee to make conditions to receive proposals in what conditions the poor of said town shall be let out upon in future and it passed in the affirmative then the town voted to appoint the Selectmen for that purpose and to leave it discretionary with them to close a bargain with any one who should appear to take the poor for a term of years if they thought it most for the benefit and interest to the Town

2^d Article the Committee appointed to procure a Meeting house last year made their report, said report was in favor of making a new one to repair to the Meeting house. then a motion was made to accept of said report it was put to vote and it passed in the affirmative 54 voted for it and 52 against it, then a motion was made to reconsider the vote last past and it passed in the affirmative then a motion was made to take of the roof of the house and passed in the negative then a motion was made to paint the meeting house and it passed in the negative

3^d Article passed over not acted upon

4th Article not acted upon passed over

5th Article chose a Committee of five for the purpose of looking up the plan of the Meeting house Common and the Gentlemen Selectmen were appointed for that purpose

6th Article being previously acted upon then took up the

7th Article Voted to open the road laid out by the Selectmen in Feb. 7 last through Capt Wm Rice and Capt Silly Smiths lands and excepted at our last annual March Meeting twenty eight voted for it, and nineteen against it Capt Rice to receive fifty dollars for land and the petitioners to make the fence through Capt Rices land for thirty five dollars Then the Town by their vote dissolved the Meeting
