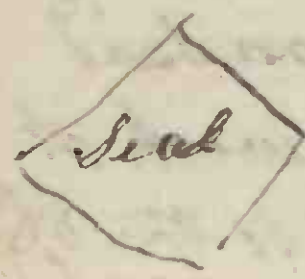

wealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn the Inhabi-
-tents of said town qualified by Law to vote in town
affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said town on
Monday the 20th day of December Instant at 1 O'clock
in the afternoon then and there to act on the following
Articles (viz.)

1st To chuse a Moderator

2^d To see if the town will chuse an agent or agents to
attend the Court of Sessions to be holden at Cambridge on
the first Tuesday of January next to oppose a Stratting
of a road petitioned for by James Wilder and others from
Bolton line and so on through the north part of Sudbury
to Waltham to do or act any way on this article as the
town shall think best when Meet.

this Warrant with your doings there on to some
one of the Selectmen previous to the opening of said
Meeting - - - - -
