of the Town of Sudbury in said County Greeting
you are required in the Name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the Freeholders
and other inhabitant of the Town of Sudbury Qualified
by Law to vote in the chois of Town officers and Town
affairs to Assemble at the Meeting House in said Town
on Monday the 7th day of March next at 12 O'clock
at noon on said day then and there to act on the following
Articles (viz) - - - - -

- 1st To choos a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r,
Assessors Constable and all other Town officers required
by Law to be annually chosen in the Month of March
or April.
- 2^d To see if the Town will repair their Highway by rate
the presant year and grant a suitable Sum of Money
for repairing the same.
- 3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for Swine to go at large
the presant year.
- 4th To see if the Town will give liberty horses & Mules to
go at large and neat cattle to go at large the presant year.
- 5th To see if the Town will give liberty for Sheep to go at
large the presant year with a Shepherd.
- 6th To see if the will take the same Measures for the
purpos of collecting the Taxes that may be assessed upon
the Inhabitants of said town as was adopted the year
past and to agree with some suitable person or persons or
~~persons~~ to collect the same for the year ensuing to do
or act as the Town shall think best when met.
- 7th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons
for a School committee and ortherise them to agree
with and hire School instructors & instructres to
instruct of the Public Schools in said Town for the
year ensuing.
- 8th To see if the Town will attend to the report of the
trustees of the Sudbury Ministerial fund Corporation
the State of the fund and the Interest arising there on.
