8th Article, report of the Ministerial fund Incorporation was read and excepted as here after recorded (viz) Agreeable to an act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts passed June 14th 1817 establishing a Ministerial fund in the Town of Sudbury making it a duty of the trustees thereof to make a report to said town the state of the fund and their doings thereon at the annual Meeting in the month of March or April, agreeable to said act said trustees ask leave to report of following viz The funded sum consists of the following promissary notes of hand Interest to be paid annually the 30 day of August (viz)

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Total amount of funded sum - - \$3200⁰⁰ 96

The Interest arising from the funded sum which was due August 30th 1824, amounted to the sum of \$192⁰⁰ 05 which sum the Treasurer has since paid to the Revd Rufus Hurlbut agreeable to said act of Incorporation
