

April Anno Domini 1825

At a legal Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts in Town Meeting Assembled Qualified by the Constitution to vote for Governor L^{ut}. Governor of said Commonwealth and Senators for the Middlesex District holden on Monday the 4th day of April 1825 Then the Inhabitants proceeded to the business of said day by bringing in their votes for the following persons (viz.)

Gov^r Hon. Levi Lincoln one hundred and twenty two votes
Nelson Barnet one vote

For L^{ut}. His Honour Marcus Morton one hundred and nine votes
Gov^r Hon. Levi Lincoln one vote

For
Senators Hon. John Keyes one hundred & fifteen votes
Hon. Seth Knowles one hundred votes
Hon. John Wade one hundred votes
Hon. Micah M. Rutter one hundred & one vote
Abel Jewett Esq ninety nine votes
Nathan Chandler thirteen votes
Samuel Hoar Esq fifteen votes
Edmund Parker Esq fourteen votes
Joseph Valentine Esq fourteen votes
Luther Lawrence Esq three votes
Luke Fisk Esq - one vote
Rev^d Charles Train two votes
