Middlesex Co. To Mr. Samuel Knight Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County greeting

Seal you are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the Inhabitants
of said Town qualified by Law to vote in the choice of
Representative and all others to vote in the choice of
Town officers and Town affairs to meet at the meeting
House in said Town on Monday the 4th day of April
next at 3 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then
and there to act on the following articles viz

1st To chuse a Moderator

2^d To bring in their votes for some suitable person for
a County Treasurer for the year ensuing -

3^d To chuse a Town Treasurer, and Constable (the choice
of which was put off to April Meeting) and fill all other
vacancies in Town officers that shall appear to vacate

4th To act on the 6th Article in the warrant of March
Meeting which was put over to April Meeting -

5th To see if the will take any Measures if any what
measures in making any further repairs to the highway
and road near Mr. John Haynes and so on to Concord
line -

6th To see if the Town except of the Settlement of the Selectmen
with the Town Treasury and order the same to be
recorded -

7th To attend to the report of Committees if any reports
are offered -

8th To see if the Town will appoint a Committee to examine
and adjust all accounts that shall be brot in against
said Town -

warrant with your doings there on to some one of the
Selectmen previous to the opening of said Meeting
given under our hand and seal at Sudbury aforesaid
this 21 day of March A.D. 1825.
