

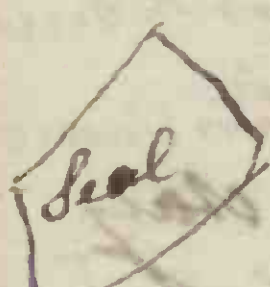
May Anno Domini 1825 ~ ~ ~

to represent them in the General Court to be held at Boston on the 2^d of May
the Lament year for the choice of one representative
did then and there elect Abel Wheeler having the
number of forty four votes Asper Goodnow had
the Number of thirty 32 votes

3^d To see if the Town will grant the Revd Rufus Hurlbut
his Salary the year ensuing in addition to the Trust

4th To see if the Town grant money for the support of
a grammar school and order where the same shall
be kept 144.1

5th To see if the Town will grant Money for a reading and
writing school and order where the same shall be
