

..... May Anno Domini 1825

At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 23^d day of May A.D. 1825. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of William Hunt Esq for Moderator of said Meeting

2^d Article the Selectmen made a report that they had widened the road near Mr Stephen Haynes house on the South side of the now traveled road and set up stakes for bounds there of on said Haynes land, and assessed the damage to said Haynes twenty Dollars, which report was accepted.

3^d Article, Voted to take Measures to repair Sandy hill near Mr Stephen Haynes and granted the sum of one hundred and eighty Dollars for the purpose of repairing the road up said hill and paying Mr Stephen Haynes for his land, and chose a committee of three persons for the purpose of letting out said repairs and the following gentlemen were chosen by ballot (viz)

William Hunt Esq Asper Goodnow Esq. and Mr Amos Conant, then the Town Voted that the committee be directed to let out said repairs to the best advantage to the Town and to report to the Town at some future meeting

4th Article, Voted to appoint a committee for the purpose of viewing the South road, said committee to consist of three persons to be nominated by the Moderator, then the Moderator nominated Mr Jotham Goodnow, left Thielder and Mr Adam Howe, then left Thielder excused himself from serving on said committee and Mr Michl Balcom was appointed in his stead, then the Town Voted to excuse all the committee last appointed and chose the number of five on said committee and to chose them by ballot and the following gentlemen were chosen (viz) Mr Michl Balcom, left Abel Cutting, left Drury Fairbanks, left Israel Haynes and left Samuel Jones for the purpose of viewing said road and to report to the Town their opinion of the expediency of making straightenings on said road on the first Monday in September next ensuing

5th Article. passed over not acted upon
