

May Anno Domini 1825

6th Article Voted to appropriate the sum of thirty five dollars for their Soldiers a Dinner on Muster day all that do Duty on said day to be laid out the same way and manner as was the last year. Then voted to appropriate the remaining part of the money for the purpose of taking up out standing orders

7th Article the Selectmen made a report respecting the staking out the road on Lakes end Hill said report was rejected and not accepted

8th Article It was moved and seconded to put over this article and it passed in the negative then the Town voted give liberty for the Center School District to remove their School House to some convenient spot on the Common where the District should agree upon. Then the Town voted to adjourn this meeting to the first Monday of September next at this place at 2 o'clock in the afternoon

The Town being most agreeable to the afore going adjournment proceeded upon the business of said day by acting on the unfinished part of the 4th Article the Committee which was appointed at the former Meeting made their report which was accepted by the Town and ordered it to be recorded said report is as follows (viz). Your Committee appointed in May last for the purpose of examining the South gate road have attended that Service and ask leave to report as follows (viz) It is our opinion provided a streeting must take place we think it expedient to begin near Mr John Brown Jr barn and running nearly a straight line to the Mill Bridge
