You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to Notify and warn all the Inhabitants of
said Town qualified by Law to vote Town affairs to meet at the
Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 5th day September
next at 3 O'clock in the afternoon then and there to act
on the following Articles (viz)

1st To choose a Moderator

2^d To see if the Town will grant or appropriate money suf-
-ficient to pay the expence of making the road through the land
Capt. William Rice.

3^d To Attend to reports of Committees if any reports are made

4th To see if the Town except of a road as laid out by the selectmen
through the land of William Smith and Son to land of Levi Smith

5th To see if the town will take any measures to repair the bridge
near Mr. Israel Hunts to do or act se

Here of you are not to fail of making a return of of this
warrant with your doings there on to some one of the select-
-men previous to the opening of said meeting.
