At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday
the 5th day of September A.D. 1825-

proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the
1st Article and made choice of Wm. Hunt Esq Moderator

2^d Article ~~no reports were made~~ granted the sum of
one hundred forty seven dollars for the purpose of
finishing the road through the land of Capt Wm. Rice

3^d Article passed over no reports being made-----

4th Article passed over for the present, then took up the

5th Article it was moved and seconded to appoint a committee
of three persons, for the purpose of making the repairs of
the bridge near Mr. Israel Hunt's and it passed in the
affirmative then the town appointed William Hunt Esq
Capt Israel Haynes, and Capt Tilley Haynes, for the
purpose as above mentioned then the town instructed
the committee to let out said bridge to the best advantage
and interest to the town as in their opinion shall seem best
and to make said bridge safe for the ensuing fall and winter
and to report to the town at some future town meeting

Then took up the 4th Article, then the Selectmen made
a report that they had laid out a bridle way through
the land William Smith and William Smith Jr and the
town accepted said report upon conditions (viz)
provided that Live Smith gives bonds to the town to
the satisfaction of the Selectmen to indemnify and save
the town from any expense whatever in consequence
of said bridle way being laid out thro' said Wm Smith
land said bond to be given on or before the 15th day of October
next otherwise to be null and void and of no effect. The said
report to be recorded in the Book of records of roads
when the bond is ratified.

Then the town by their vote dissolved this meeting
