noon on said day, then and there to act on the follow=

- 1st To choose a Moderator Town Clerk, Selectmen Town
Treasurer Assessors, Constable and all other Town
officers required by Law to be chosen in the
month of March or April ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 2^d To bring in their Votes for Register of Deeds
for the County of Middlesex ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 3^d To see if the Town will repair their Highway
by vote the present year and grant a suitable
money for repairing the same
- 4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Swine=
Horses, Mules, neat cattle, and Sheep to go at large
the present year ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- 5th To see if the Town will take the same Measures
for the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may be
Assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town as was
adopted the last year and to agree with some suitable
person or persons to collect the same the year ensuing
to do or act as the Town shall think best when met
- 6th To see if the Town appoint a School Committee and
and authorize them to agree with and hire School
Instructors and Instructresses to instruct the
Schools in said Town the year ensuing —
- 7th To see if the Town will attend to the report of the trustees
of the Sudbury Ministerial Fund Corporation the State of
