

March Anno Domini 1826

At a Town Meeting Legally held in Sudbury on Monday the 6th day of March A.D. 1826. Proceeded to the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of Capt. William Brigham for Moderator then proceeded to the choice of Town officers as follows (viz)

3^d Article voted to repair the Highways by a rate the present year and granted the sum of one thousand Dollars for that purpos. Voted that the price of labour be the same as was the last year.

4th Article, passed in the negative - - - - -

6th Article, voted to pass over for the present and took up the
