At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury in the
County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Mass=
achusetts in town Meeting Assembled Qualified by
the Constitution to vote for Gov^r & Lt Gov^r of said
Commonwealth and Senators for the Middlesex District
held on Monday the 3^d day of April 1826.
