2nd Then took up the 2nd Article again and made choice of Martin Brown for their Constable and collector of Taxes and to give bonds to the satisfaction of the town Treasurer for the collecting of Taxes and paying in the same as he shall be ordered by the Assessors, Then it was moved and seconded that the School Committee ~~be~~ which was chosen at the last March Meeting be re-chosen at this Meeting in consequence of the late School act, and it passed in the affirmative and voted to add one more to that number and proceeded to the choice by nomination as follows (viz) Rev^d Rufus Thurlbut, Dr Thomas Stearns, Capt Abner Goodnow, Josiah H Adams, Esq. Capt Israel Haynes, and Mr Buckley House were chosen for that purpose. Then took up the

4th Article containing the 8th Article of March meeting and referred to April Meeting. it being moved and seconded to see if the town will give liberty for tombs to be built as was expressed in said Article and it passed in the affirmative. then voted to choose a Committee of five persons for the purpose of locating the ground where said tombs are proposed to be built and conferring with the petitioners of the ^{near said tombs} ~~most~~ to be built upon so as to have them built upon a uniform plan and the following ~~And~~ Gentlemen were chosen for that purpose viz Capt Isaac Gibbs Capt Abner Goodnow, Capt Wm Brigham, Mr Micah Balcom and Capt Wm Rice. Then took up the 13th Article contained in the 4th article and voted to choose three auditors of accounts as mentioned in the 13th article of March Meeting and the following Gentlemen were chosen viz Mr Paul Walker Capt William Rice and Abner Goodnow for the purpose as expressed in said Article

5th Then the Town voted to except of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded which is as follows
