6th Attended to reports of Committee, the Committee which was appointed at March Meeting to revise the Rules and orders of the Schools in said town made a report and is as here after recorded...

your Committee would therefore recommend that the two first Sections of the late act dated March 4th 1826 which must necessarily be the bases of all regulations on the subject to be considered as the two first sections of the School regulations on the subject in this town to which they would add the following third Section viz) and it shall be the duty of the School Committee to establish one uniform system of Discipline to be observed in all the public Schools, and also to see that all of the public Schools of the same denomination commence at the same time and that each and every instruction of said Schools be furnished with an attested copy of the foregoing regulations to gother with the system of discipline which said School Committee shall establish -

Then the town accepted the above report and ordered the same to be recorded

Then the same Committee reported upon the division of the of the School Grants or new Districting, and it was not accepted. Then the town voted to refer the whole subject matter to the same Committee and for them to report to the town at May Meeting their doings

7th The Town voted to appoint a Committee of three persons to examine the local Bridge to see if needed rebuilding and to report to the town at May Meeting their opinion what is best to be done with said bridge - and After Goodnow Esq Mr. Luther Goodnow - and Capt Samuel Jones were chosen for that purpose
