10th Voted to put over this article to May Meeting for further consideration - - - -

11th The Town voted to choose a committee of three persons to look into the subject matter as expressed in said Article and report to the Town at May Meeting and the selectmen were chosen for that purpose

12th The Town voted that the selectmen be directed to view said premises and report to the Town their opinion what is best to be done for the interest to the ^{Town} at May Meeting - - - -

Then the Town by their vote dissolved this Meeting
