Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify
and warn all the Inhabitants of said town of
Sudbury qualified by the Constitution and Laws
of this Commonwealth to vote in the choice
of a Representative to meet at the meeting
house in said town on Monday the 1st day of
May next at 1 O'clock in the afternoon
on said day then and there to choose a Represen-
tative to Represent them in the General Court
appointed to be convened and held at Boston
on the last day Wednesday of May next

return of this Warrant with your doings
there on to some one of the Selectmen
previous to the opening of said Meeting
