on Monday the 1st day of May A.D. 1826.

proceeded upon the business of said day by bringing in
their votes for abbeysantation and Abel Wheeler

three. and Josiah H. Adams & ^{one} vote
then the town by their ^{votes} dissolved this Meeting

wealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the In-
habitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified by Law
to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in
said town on Monday the 1st day of May next at
2 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there
to act on the following Articles (vitz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator of said Meeting
- 2^d To see if the Town will grant money for the purpose of pay-
ing the accounts that shall be brot in against said town
and allowed by the committee on accounts for the year ensuin^g
- 3^d To if the Town will grant the Rev^d Rufus Huntbert
his salary the year ensuin^g in addition to the interest
arising from the Ministerial fund
