- 4th To see if the Town will grant money for the support of grammar school and order where the same shall be kept
- 5th To see if the Town will grant money for a reading and writing school and order where the same shall be kept
- 6th To see if the Town will grant money for the support of the poor the present year
- 7th To see if the Town will grant money to pay their Treas^r and Assessors the present year
- 8th To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to let out the taking care of the Meeting house and sweeping the same ringing the bell and digging graves as occasion may require
- 9th To act on the 10th article in the warrant of April meeting and referred to May Meeting for further consideration
- 10th To see if the Town will attend to the reports of committees which were ordered to be made at May Meeting and all other reports which committees have to make if any are offered
- 11th To see what measures the Town will take respecting their bargins which the Town made during their pleasure (some years since) with Capt Jon^a Bent deceased respecting the maintaining of the road from Cold Brook highway to Concord line to do, or act as the Town shall think best when met.
- 12th To see if the town will discount to constable Knight certain taxes that can't be collected.
- 13th To see if the town will appropriate any money in the Treasurers not otherwise appropriated for to furnish the soldiers a dinner and powder on Muster day -
- 14th To see if the town will take any measures to prevent the inhabitants of said town inclosing any of the Highways and to prohibit the digging and carrying of the soil out of the roads to improve the same
- 15th To see if the town will paint the Meeting house and grant a suitable sum of money to pay the expense thereof
