

May Anno Domini 1826

16th To see if the Town will grant a suitable sum of Money for the purchase of furnishing the Schollars with School Books agreeable to a late act of the Legislature

17th To see if the Town will appropriate out of any unappropriated money now in the Treasury the sum of five Dollars and eighty three cents for cash paid to make up the deficiency in the town standard of weights and measures, also to see if the town will appropriate to their road committee any sum that they should see fit to enable them to pay their evidencees and Surveyor on said roads...

Hereof you are not to fail of making your return of this warrant with your doings, then on to some one of the Selectmen previous to the spring of said meeting
