- 3^d Article granted to the Reverend Rufus Hurlbut his Salary in addition to the Interest arising from the Ministerial fund the sum of \$ 457.⁹⁴
- 4th Article granted for the support of the Grammar Schools to be equally divided among the five School Districts -- 375.⁰⁰
also granted the sum of forty ^{five} Dollars for wood -- 45.⁰⁰
- 5th Article granted for the support of a reading Schools to be equally divided in the five School Districts the sum of 200.⁰⁰
- 6th Article granted ~~the sum of~~ for the support of the Poor 900.⁰⁰
- 7th Article granted the sum of ten Dollars for their Treas^r 10.⁰⁰
also granted the sum of twenty Dollars for their Assessors 20.⁰⁰
- 8th Article directed the Selectmen to let out the taking care of the Meeting House as was expressed in said Article
- 9th Article it was moved and seconded to see if the Town will paint the School Houses it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative and appointed a committee of five one to each School District and the following Gentlemen were appointed (viz) Capt Samuel Jones Asher Goodnow
Michael Jones, Mr. Micah Balcom and Capt Israel Haynes
and granted for the purpose of painting said houses the sum of one hundred Dollars -- 100.⁰⁰
to be painted with good oil and Vermilion red and to make all necessary repairs to said School Houses --
- 10th Article the committee appointed at April Meeting for the purpose of viewing the Lanel Bridge reported in favor of rebuilding said Bridge this Season, and the report was accepted and voted to appoint the same gentleman a committee who viewed and made the report to lay the same into effect and to be left with the committee to build said bridge the best way and manner that they should think would be for the interest to the town and granted for that purpose the sum of -- \$ 200.⁰⁰
and to account to the Town the expense of building said bridge as soon as may be after the work is done --
- 11th Article voted that the Selectmen be directed to put the said road into Highway limits and that the Assessors be directed said Bents farm in p^r to the Highways
